PROBLEM STATEMENT

- Over 50.6% of Cameroonians live below \$1/day
- ❖ About 2 million of underprivileged children especially orphans in Cameroon
- Ongoing Anglophone Crisis has increased this number
- ❖ Little exposure of vulnerable groups mostly orphans to ICT skills
- Skill development is therefore a major challenge

SOLUTION

- ❖ To teach, train, and empower underprivileged children with ICT skills needed to start a self-sustaining lifebeginning with Cameroon with a target of establishing computer laboratories in orphanage homes and poor communities thereby reducing poverty and improving access to quality education.
- Bridging the gap between talented ,poor ,smart kids with high potential with scholarship and grant opportunities

CORE ACTIVITIES

- Training on ICT skills (MS Word, Excel, Publisher, Web Navigation, Internet, Video Editing)
- Advertisement
