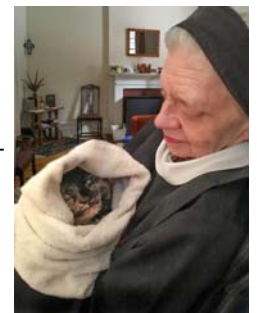


NEWS FROM NYC
